## WHY STAGE THIS "CALL FOR IDEAS" AGAIN?

The rich mix of existing landscape resources at SLU positions it to take a leadership role in addressing some of society's most pressing environmental challenges.

To animate SLU's many landscape topic area assets and capacities in dynamic new ways, this Call for Ideas sponsors concrete initiatives to plant seeds of cross-departmental, cross campus synergies between existing SLU Landscape teaching, research and outreach resources.

A total of 200 000 SEK will be equally distributed to support up to 5 implementable ideas that make landscape topic work more visible within the SLU community, help promote SLU efforts to build external research networks, and/or contribute to strengthening SLU's educational offerings.

## WHAT IS THE TIMEFRAME?

Project ideas must be realized in 8 months (Jan -Aug)

## WHAT FORM MIGHT THESE ACTION-ORIENTED IDEAS TAKE?

Anything that triggers benefits of resource synergy: joint excursions, cross-disciplinary courses, staff development seminars, marketing strategies, inter-departmental research seminars, joint teaching formats, collaborative method workshops, inter-disciplinary education modules, pedagogical courses, collaborative teaching tools, workshops exploring integrated research and teaching... you get the idea!

## WHAT DOES A TEAM NEED TO SUBMIT IN THEIR PROPOSAL?

- **LIST WHO IS INVOLVED** - and identify main focus (education, outreach, research, etc.)
- **DESCRIBE HOW THE PROJECT WILL BE REALIZED** - include a simple action plan, 8-month time-line, and preliminary budget
- **EXPLAIN WHAT WILL RESULT** - and how team, departments and LTV Faculty benefit
- **ARGUE WHY IT MATTERS** - immediate and long-term
