Swedish forests

- Reforestation since 1903 > more biomass-> more wildlife
- 28 million hectares
 - 23 million hectares productive forests
- Conifer dominance (>80%)
 - Norway spruce (>40%) and Scots pine (<40%)
 - Mixed forests (>10%) with Birch sp
 - Hard woods (oak) in the south





Ownership

- ~50% private non-industrial owners
 - 320 000 individual forest owners
- 25% larger forest companies
- 20% state
- 5 % church & municipalities forests





Industry

- Export-oriented
 - 3% of GDP
- Paper and wood products
 - Cardboard increasing
- 10% of world export markets, from 1% of the forest area
- A current shift towards biobased materials & biofuels





Use

- Forestry
- Outdoor & Recreation
- Reindeer herding
- Carbon sink (CCS)






