SSF Adjunct Professor “A-Pro”, 2020

The Swedish Foundation for Strategic Research has allocated SEK 15 million for about 10 grants in an Adjunct Professorship program.

This Call is directed to highly-qualified individuals employed by Swedish industry, government agency or health care provider who seeks appointment as adjunct professor at a Swedish Higher Education Institution (HEI) for a period of three to six years to an extent of at least 20 percent. During the exchange period the Adjunct Professor shall conduct strategic research that meets the Foundations' purpose.
