

Template for pre-proposals for Wallenberg Scholars at SLU

According to the KAW guidelines, all applications submitted to the Wallenberg Scholars programme must undergo an internal prioritization process at the nominating university. At SLU, researchers who want to be nominated for the programme are asked to submit a pre-proposal, which is assessed by a specially appointed prioritization group tasked with recommending candidates for nomination by the Vice-Chancellor. Before submitting your application, carefully read KAW's guidelines for Wallenberg Scholars and consider the following:

- The target group for the programme is well-established senior researchers who are international leaders in their respective research fields.
- The Wallenberg Scholars programme is open to researchers in all scientific disciplines, but it accepts the largest number of researchers working in areas prioritized by KAW, i.e. natural sciences, technology and medicine.
- The fundamental objective of KAW is to support basic research of the highest international standard.
- Researchers who are nominated for the Wallenberg Scholars programme must have a permanent position at a Swedish university and spend at least 70% of their working time in Sweden.

The pre-proposal is made by following the instructions provided in Appendix 1 of the "Internal guidelines for nomination to Wallenberg Scholars at SLU", using this pre-proposal template as the cover page. A full pre-proposal should be submitted as a compiled PDF, consisting of the following parts:

- 1) Wallenberg Scholars pre-proposal form
- 2) CV (max. 3 pages, please find suggested template [here](#))
- 3) Publication list
- 4) Project description (max. 2 pages)
- 5) Brief motivation (max. 1 page)

The pre-proposal should be written in English and submitted to Ansok-KAW@slu.se no later than the 16th of December 2022.
