Dear colleagues and interested parties,

We would like to express our sincere gratitude for your interest in Ukraine and our veterinary educational project - the Ukrainian School of Veterinary Medicine (USVM). Your contributions and engagement in the Ukrainian veterinary community during these challenging times will ignite sparks of hope and never will be forgotten. We strongly believe Ukraine is a member of the European family, so we are working tirelessly to enhance the standards of veterinary education in Ukraine, aligning it with European benchmarks.

The Ukrainian School of Veterinary Medicine started its function on September 1st, 2023 to enhance postgraduate veterinary education, and provide undergraduate veterinary students (who have an online format of education over 2 years) with the guidance and support mental state of veterinary practitioners, affected by the Russian war against Ukraine.

The education process was launched in the two safest cities, Kyiv and Lviv, with four sections in each city (eight sections in total). Each section's training comprises one lecturing day a month for four months (32 hours in total), and upon finishing the training, the student receives the certificate of completion. The total amount of academic hours conducted in 2023 amounts to 256 hours. The lectures are held by carefully selected and competent teachers who have professional experience over 5 years and scientific achievements in veterinary medicine. Lecturers utilize unique educational programs, personally developed under the principles of modern evidence-based veterinary medicine.

The Ukrainian School of Veterinary Medicine project is expanding and for the next year, we plan on having two offline semesters (spring and fall semesters) in Kyiv and Lviv; launching new sections of veterinary ophthalmology, abdominal surgery, veterinary parasitology, veterinary orthopedics, visual diagnostics, veterinary endocrinology, laboratory diagnostics of animal diseases and veterinary surgery; organizing 3 specialized forums on the following topics: dermatology, dietology and nutrition, infectious diseases. The greatest event of USVM in 2024 would be the three-day Congress of the Ukrainian School of Veterinary Medicine from 13.06.2024 to 15.06.2024 with 15 sections and 3 practical workshops in dermatology, cytology, and visual diagnostics.



How can you participate in the life of the USVM?

We are offering two possible ways of our collaboration, online and offline formats.

Online:

• <u>**Giving online lectures**</u>, preferably previously recorded on a topic related to the theme of the section classes/congress/forums. The idea is to broadcast them during the classes of the USVM.

Nowadays in the realities of Ukraine with constant blackouts and shortage of electricity caused by Russian rocket strikes, we are unfortunately unable to guarantee a high-quality Internet connection. That's why the broadcasting of recorded lectures can be a possible solution.

We ensure the copyright protection of your intellectual property and will prevent any unauthorized use or distribution of the lecturing materials. We guarantee the use of lecturing materials only and exclusively during our USVM classes and only with your permission.

The list of possible topics for online lectures will be attached to this letter for your review.

• Access to online platforms with educational materials.

We have positive examples of obtaining access through a continuing partnership with Tufts University and WSAVA to their educational websites and literature.

If your institution is willing to contribute to veterinary education in Ukraine in such a way, it would be highly appreciated. Again, we ensure the copyright protection of your intellectual property and will prevent any unauthorized use or distribution of the materials. The access will be granted only to those, registered as members of USVM.



Offline:

• <u>Conducting offline lectures</u> in the forums and USVM Congress from June 13, 2024, to June 15, 2024.

We invite all the interested lecturers and teachers who are eager to present during the USVM Congress or any other USVM Forums. Accommodation and meals will be provided from our side, while all the travel expenses are to be covered on your end.

Air travel to Ukraine is currently suspended; however, it is still possible to reach Ukraine via an extensive network of train and bus connections from Poland and other neighboring countries. Upon your arrival in Ukraine, we can arrange for your escort.
