



Invitation to nominate candidates to the new Faculty Board 2022-2024

Those entitled to vote* within the S-faculty will this autumn elect eight members and two deputies to the Faculty Board regarding the period 2022-2024. Among the eight ordinary members, the chairperson (dean) and vice chairperson (deputy dean) are also appointed.

In a first nomination procedure, all employees at the S-faculty, are hereby invited to nominate candidates, including those who are not entitled to vote in the elections this autumn.

The majority of the members of the Faculty Board shall be part of the Faculty's Electoral Assembly*.

The nominations shall state:

1. That the nominee has been consulted and accepted the assignment.
2. If the nomination refers to the assignment as
 - Member/deputy, or
 - Chairperson or vice chairperson
3. A brief motivation.

Nominations are sent to valberedningen.sfak@slu.se **no later than August 31.**

After the nomination period, the nomination committee will present a proposal for a new Faculty Board which will be presented to those entitled to vote* on October 4. Thereafter, the nomination committee invites those entitled to vote* to submit additional nominations. The election rules, the election committee's proposal and information on additional nominated candidates will be announced to those entitled to vote* no later than ten days before the election. A digital hearing with the candidates will be arranged during the period 26-28 October. The exact date will be announced later. The election period takes place during 25 October – 2 November.

4 Faculty electoral assemblies and voting rights at faculty board elections

4.1 Composition

In order to be part of a faculty electoral assembly, an employee must work at least half-time and hold a position that is permanent for a given consecutive period no shorter than two years in total. The employee must hold the position of professor, senior lecturer, associate senior lecturer, researcher¹, environmental assessment specialist, post-doctor, lecturer, analyst, research group leader, experiment group leader, field mycologist, field pathologist or field entomologist.

4.2 Voting rights at faculty board elections

During faculty board elections, the following people are entitled to vote:

- a) the faculty electoral assembly;
- b) those with a doctorate who are employed at a faculty and hold a position that is at least half-time and permanent for a given consecutive period no shorter than two years in total.
