

Annex 8: Information to include on the cover and title page of independent projects (degree projects) at SLU

The language on the cover and title page (sometimes referred to as page 3) should be the same as the language used for the paper itself.

If more than one university has provided supervision, they should be listed and it should be clear that SLU is the publisher and the examining university.

The cover should have the following information:

- SLU logotype
- Faculty or department, depending on which unit is responsible for the series the paper is published in. If the paper is not part of a series, state the name of the faculty.
- Title and any subtitle, in the main language (the language the paper is written in)
- Author
- Publication year

If applicable, the following should also be indicated on the cover:

- Title of the series (can be in Swedish and English)
- Part number
- Series
- ISSN
- Programme, example: *Forest Science – Master's programme*

If it is not already clear from other information, the following should be added:

- Place of publication
- *Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences*
- *Independent project or degree project*
- Scope, indicated in credits. Should be placed immediately after either *Independent project* or *Degree project*.

The following can also be added:

- Title and any subtitle, in a language other than the one the paper is written in. If the title is translated, any subtitle must also be translated.

The title page should have the following information:

- SLU, Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences, and immediately after this, the name of the faculty
- Author
- Title and any subtitle, in the main language
- Keywords describing the content, in the main language
- Supervisor: name, university and department
- Examiner: name, university and department
- Course title, example: *Independent project in rural development*
- Course code, example: *EX0523*
- Department responsible
- Scope, indicated in credits. Example: *10 credits, 15 credits, 30 credits*
- Level and specialisation. Example: *Grund AB, Grund C, Avancerad D, Avancerad E* (for projects started up until the 2009/2010 academic year) Exempel: *G1E, G2E, A1E, A2E* (for projects started 2010/11 or later)
- Place of publication, example: *Alnarp, Skara, Skinnskatteberg, Umeå, Uppsala*
- Publication year

If applicable, the following should also be added:

- Title, and any subtitle, in a language other than the one the paper is written in.
- Assistant supervisor: name, university and department
- Title of series, part number and ISSN
- Programme

The department can provide information on series title (if applicable), part number and ISSN. Information on the name of the programme, level and specialisation, course title, course code and scope are available in Ladok (the student records database) or Slunik (course information).
