General description of research and teaching

Specialised in farm animal welfare in general and poultry welfare in particular. Farm animal welfare at the time of slaughter and killing, including religious slaughter. Animal welfare legislation, private animal welfare standards and official animal welfare control aspects also covered. Research also related to the welfare of wildlife in research situations. Research mainly focused on farm animal welfare including health, behaviour and management aspects and preventive herd health for dairy and beef cattle, poultry, pigs and lamb. Animal handling and equipment improvement, plus training of staff, in relation to animal welfare during transport and at slaughterhouses and on-farm killing, including emergency slaughter and depopulation for disease control purposes. Research on antibiotic resistance dispersal. Some research related to companion and laboratory animal welfare, and wildlife.

Teaching animal husbandry and animal welfare, including crisis preparedness and management, to veterinary students, animal science students and animal welfare & ethology students. Also teaching animal welfare as part of continuous education programmes for official veterinarians and animal welfare inspectors.
